Expanding Student Social & Emotional Support

The COVID-19 pandemic had significant impact on the social and emotional well-being of children, but even before March 2020, cases of anxiety and depression were on the rise among children 3-17.

In response to the increased need for social and emotional support demonstrated by students, Springmont has added new resources to our curriculum.



Last year Ann Van Buskirk joined the Springmont community as our School Counselor. Ann retired from the DeKalb County School District after serving there for the past 31 years. She is a licensed Clinical Psychologist and a Certified School Psychologist, as well as an adjunct faculty member of the Psychology department at Emory University. Ann works with individual students, small groups of students, Elementary & Middle School classes, parents, and families.

This year we have added Kimberly Robinson to support our youngest children in Toddler and Primary. She can be found observing in classrooms and offering support to faculty who have students with developmental concerns. We are also happy to welcome Chaela Nutor, a graduate student from Emory doing a practicum under Ann, to Springmont each Wednesday.

Finally, we have established a new soft sensory space on campus supported by Title IV Funding through the state. This is a place where students may go to regulate their emotions, and practice strategies for optimal energy level. The expectation is that this designated area will improve student ability to attend to lessons and collaborate with other students, as well as decrease class disruptions that occur when students experience dysregulation.

At Springmont, we pride ourselves on meeting each student where they are and are thrilled to offer a greater suite of social/emotional support services this year!

The Middle School Returns to the Landschool

Our Middle School Class was excited to kick off the 2022-23 school year with a trip to the Landschool. Given renovations and health/safety concerns of the pandemic, the Landschool has sat largely unused for the past couple years. Molly Devinney graduated from Woodward Academy and is attending Texas Christian University where she plans to earn a Business Degree.



Rosie Meizen attended The Galloway School and has started her study of Biochemistry at Georgia Tech.
